All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by contacting the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Dr., Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 57617-3390, by phone (919) 233-9767, by email at info@akc.org, or on their website at www.akc.org.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The SSCSN and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The SSCSN reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the SSCSN or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC Entry form for this event.

REFUNDS

No refund will be made for overpayment of \$6.00 or less.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, a public emergency, act of a public enemy, weather or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Refunds for injured dogs or handlers: 50% refunds will be given for a dog or handler that has a note from their veterinarian or doctor saying they cannot participate in the show. The doctor's appointment must have been before the show.

Full Entry fees will be refunded if an entry is pulled before the closing date/ time.

Online convenience fees will not be refunded for any reason.

Duplicate entries will be fully refunded.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Bitches in season are not allowed on the show grounds. As such, the club will issue full refund minus \$5.00 processing fee for bitches unable to compete for this reason if the Trial Secretary receives WRITTEN notice of withdrawal no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

Change of judge, after the distribution of the premium list, if the judging assignment changes, an exhibitor has the right to request a full refund of their entry fees for any class affected. Exhibitors must submit requests in writing to the Trial Secretary a minimum of 30 minutes preceding the start of the event on the first day the exhibitor is entered

WAITLIST

SSCSN IS OFFERING A WAIT LIST to fill openings made by withdrawn entries after the trial's official close. Only paper entries can be waitlisted. Online entries are not eligible for waitlisting. All entries, including waitlisted entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary by 11:00 p.m. on the trial's closing date. A maximum of fifty (50) runs will be placed on the club's wait list. Any entry that is withdrawn by 6 p.m. on Monday, Oct 24, 2016, will be replaced by a waitlisted entry IF any of the fifty (50) runs are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a waitlisted entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any waitlisted entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Monday, Oct 24, 2016, at 6 p.m. will receive a full refund.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Overnight or certified mail must be sent with the "No Signature Required" waiver signed. ENTRIES CLOSE ON October 12, 2016, at 11:00 PM, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum and/or entries received prior to the opening date shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian’s recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

MEASURING and JUMP HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether the dog has a valid jump height card or if the dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include the dog on the *Dogs To Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of the dog’s jump height card with the entry form, however, it is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor’s responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. **Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.**

MOVE-UPS

All pre-show move ups must be received by 6pm, Monday, Oct. 24, 2016. The AKC requires move-ups to be in writing. You may send an email for a move-up to Paula at aqilesec@aol.com with your name, your dog’s call name, the name & date of the trial and what class you want the dog to be moved to. If you miss the deadline for move-ups, you may move your dog up the first day of the show for any **subsequent** days, even if you are not showing a dog that day. In addition a friend may do the move-up for you if you are not there. However, you may not move up the day of the show for that day.

There will be day-to-day move-ups at the show, provided the Trial Secretary receives them within **15 minutes after the end of the last class**. There will be no move-ups in the morning before the start of the trial. EXCEPTION: A dog which has been entered in a Novice “A” class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice “B” class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice “A” class to the Novice “B” class. **Move Down:** After the close of entries a dog may be moved down in its class level (i.e. Master to Excellent). The request must be in writing and submitted to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place – Blue, Second Place – Red, Third Place – Yellow, Fourth Place – White.

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title, while quantities are available. A MACH rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH. A PACH rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their PACH. A flat green ribbon will be awarded to all dogs that earn a qualifying score. A QQ pin will awarded to all Master dog and handler teams qualifying in both Master STD and Master JWW on the same day, while quantities are available. A QQQ pin will awarded to all Master dog and handler teams qualifying in both Master STD, Master JWW and FAST on the same day, while quantities are available. A Rosette for “High Scoring Shetland Sheepdog ” will be awarded to the Shetland Sheepdog with the best combined score -- # of QQ, # of Q, and then Time; combined seconds of SCT minus Dog’s Run Time -- from both the Saturday and Sunday trials in the Excellent-Master JWW and STD classes. A separate ribbon will be awarded to Regular and Preferred.

All prizes, awards and ribbons must be picked up before the end of the show. No ribbons, etc., will be mailed after the show.

VOLUNTEER FORM

ONLINE & CREDIT CARD ENTRIES: SSCSN is accepting 165 online entries for each day through AKC's online entry service. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries will be designated as follows: Online entries 165; Paper entries 165. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or the paper limits accordingly.

No hand deliveries or faxed entries will be accepted.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC ILP or PAL number. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, nor will aggressive dogs, bitches in season, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

PREMIER STANDARD AND PREMIER JWW

We are excited to announce the newest AKC Agility class – Premier - starting October 1, 2015. This class will provide an opportunity for agility competitors to demonstrate different handling skills than those required for the Master Level Classes in Standard & Jumpers With Weaves. The Premier class will focus on handling the sequence or sequences of the day.

Both Standard and JWW Premier courses will be Master level courses incorporating a number of elements that challenge the dog and handler in ways that are not seen on traditional AKC courses. These elements include sequences like threadles, back-side jumps, pull-throughs, layering, challenging weave pole entries, and longer running passes. One bi-directional jump or tunnel will be allowed to encourage handling strategies. Obstacle spacing on Premier courses may exceed the limits of those on Master courses.

Premier courses will use the same obstacles as the corresponding Master course. There may be 3 tunnel passes and there will be no table. A Premier course will have 19 to 21 obstacles, 3 side switches, 4 Premier Elements and 5 Challenges. Courses will be judged using AKC Master scoring and hand signals.

We will be running these two Premier courses on Friday only.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
